Application

These boats are primarily used for spill observation, transporting equipment, small material and personnel, for tending shoreline skimming and for support of shoreline treatment operations.

Description

For stability purposes and access to shallow areas the boats are typically flat bottom with slanted square bow, unsinkable filled with polyfoam at bow and under the seat. While others have a V-hull ensuring optimal handling in small waves or slightly choppy conditions on the water.
