The RCM is in charge for developing and maintaining the state of preparedness for oil spill response in the marine environment for the Sept-Îles area. With the assistance of a team of 3, the manager ensures the maintenance of the equipment, develops and implements a training program for 80 contractors and updates the regional area plans and response strategies. The manager undertakes locally the contact with the clients and the governmental agencies involved. During oil spill response in the area, the RCM will provide the initial response and will join the ECRC ~ SIMEC Spill Management Team.

Desirable qualifications include:

- Self-Motivated team player capable of functioning in a dynamic environment.
- Ability to function in challenging response situations that require occasional short-notice travel.
- Experience in managing budgets and staff.
- Environmental protection experience.
- Marine and/or industrial experience.
